ANNOTATION

of the subject " BULGARIAN LANGUAGE FOR FOREIGN STUDENTS "

Purpose of the academic subject

The study program is intended for foreign students of the specialty "Medicine", full-time studies, educational qualification degree "Master".

Objectives: The academic subject " Bulgarian language for foreign students " aims to create linguistic competence in the Bulgarian language. The aim of the course is for foreign medical students to achieve a B1 level of Bulgarian language proficiency according to CEFR. The main aim of the course is to develop the four communicative skills of *listening, reading, writing and speaking* through attractive didactic tools such as films, audio recordings, original visualisations and fun language tasks. The communicatively oriented strategy guarantees sociolinguistic adaptation in a Bulgarian-speaking environment and the acquisition of skills for individual speech expression.

Structure of the learning content: Lectures, seminars and continuous assignments set for independent work are included in the course of teaching of the academic subject.

Teaching methods and means: Teaching methods are the ways of working for the university teacher and the student, with the help of which mastery of knowledge, skills and habits is achieved, the students' worldview is formed and their abilities are developed. The following methods and tools are used in the subject "Bulgarian language for foreign students": communicative, audio-visual, integrative, translation, situational exercises, role-playing games. Certification for the seminar exercises is given only if the student has attended all the seminar exercises and passed the tests from them.

Forms of study: The study of the subject takes place in the following forms:

1. Lectures in which basic theoretical knowledge is given on the topics under consideration. The essence of the questions falling within the scope of the topics is revealed and both group and individual work on the recommended literature are tutored.
2. Seminar classes in which the topics discussed in the lecture course are put into practice. Language exercises are performed - lexical and grammatical. Homework assignments are checked and progress in mastering the studied material is monitored in the form of written and oral testing.
3. Consultations for clarifying ambiguities regarding the educational content, related to the use of specific vocabulary and clarification of basic concepts with a view to overcoming difficulties in independent work, etc.
4. The students' independent work is organized through consultations in the teacher's reception hours, through e-mail communication, joint work on scientific and professional tasks, covering current tests on a given by the teacher conducting the seminar classes topic, etc.
