Brief biographical and professional data about the candidate's development

Liliana Mircheva graduated from Varna Medical University in 2004. Since 2013, she has been an assistant in the Department of Cardiology at the First Department of Internal Medicine at Varna Medical University. In 2014, he acquired the specialty "Cardiology". Dr. Mircheva has an additional professional qualification in echocardiography - fundamental and expert level. She participated in a two-year specialized course, accredited by the European Society of Cardiology, on the problems of heart failure in Zurich, Switzerland. In 2017, Dr. Liliana Mircheva obtained the educational and scientific degree "Doctor" with the topic of her dissertation: "Optimization of care for patients with heart failure after discharge". The scientific publications presented are a total of 26 full-text publications published in refereed and non-refereed peer-reviewed journals or published in edited scientific volumes.

Out of a total of 26 scientific works presented for the competition, in 16 of them she is the independent or first author (61.53%), in 3 works (11.5%) - second author and in 7 (26%) - third and subsequent author.

Main directions of publication activity

The presented works of the candidate correspond in terms of subject matter and content in the following main areas:

I Heart failure

- 1.1. Role of outpatient programs for patients with chronic heart failure
- 1.2. Optimizing the care of heart failure patients after hospital discharge.

- 1.3. Causes and significance of heart failure rehospitalizations
- 1.4. Role of the 6-minute walk test for assessing functional capacity
- 1.5. Role of BNP in the diagnosis, treatment and follow-up of patients with heart failure
- 1.6 Congestion and heart failure
- 1.7. Drug treatment of chronic heart failure
- 1.8. Ultrafiltration as a treatment method for patients with drug-refractory chronic heart failure
- 1.9. Heart failure and depression
- 1.11 Heart failure in adult patients

II Cardio-oncology

In a separate chapter of a collective monograph, the author describes the relationship and the underlying mechanisms by which some commonly used oncological drugs affect the pumping function of the heart.

III Infective endocarditis

Application of modern recommendations for treatment and prevention of infective endocarditis in real clinical practice. An overview of the main principles in the diagnosis, prophylaxis and treatment of infective endocarditis in the 2009 European guidelines for behavior was made. Our own experience from the application of the recommendations for behavior in infectious endocarditis on the territory of UMBAL "St. Marina" - Varna.

IV Hyperuricemia

The author, together with other Bulgarian researchers, conducted the first epidemiological study of the frequency of hyperuricemia in the Bulgarian population. Researchers found an unexpectedly high prevalence of hyperuricemia in the population, with the prevalence of this unrecognized risk factor even higher in the presence of certain comorbidities

V Iron deficiency

The presented study aims to clarify the frequency of iron deficiency in patients with HF hospitalized for worsening, as well as to establish its relationship with basic prognostic parameters.

VI Valvular diseases

In the mentioned publication, an analysis of the main types of degenerative diseases of the mitral valve was made. An overview of the clinical manifestation, diagnosis and treatment methods is made.

VII Imaging diagnostics in ischemic heart disease

These two full-text publications describe the importance of computed tomography coronary angiography in the diagnosis of patients with nonobstructive and obstructive coronary heart disease.

VIII Pulmonary thromboembolism

An overview of the causes, clinical picture, methods of diagnosis and treatment in patients with pulmonary thromboembolism was made.

Teaching activity

Dr. Liliana Mircheva conducts exercises and lectures on Internal Medicine with Bulgarianlanguage Medicine students at the Medical University - Varna, First Department of Internal Medicine, Department of Cardiology. The study and workload for the last 5 years is:
